

Quitman High School Painted Parking Spots Application



Cost: \$50 (includes parking permit)-does not include supplies: paint, brushes, etc.

Rules:

- a. Parking Painting Palooza will be done on **Thursday, August 1st from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm** and Friday, **August 2nd from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm**. You must begin by noon. **NO EXCEPTIONS!** In case of inclement weather or other complications, a make-up date is scheduled for Monday, **August 5th from 7:30 am to 3:00 pm**.
- b. All designs must be approved **prior** to painting by administration. A copy of your design must be included with the signed application. Clearly draw the design and include the colors you will be using.
- c. The application is available via Mrs. Robinson in Office B. Students will be able to submit their signed application and design for approval only (no payment) to Dr. Pearson starting July 24th. **All paperwork and payment is due prior to August 1, 2019.**
 - **Only 30 spots will be available for painting and are reserved for SENIORS Only!**
 - **Spots are sold on a first come first serve basis.**
 - **Only one parking spot may be purchased per individual.**
- d. Students will be notified by administration if their design is not acceptable. **You must follow this design exactly on painting day – NO changes allowed.**
- e. Students must provide their own **water-based, latex paint** and supplies. Water based exterior latex paint is recommended and can be found at home improvement, hardware, and paint stores.
 - **NO Spray Paint**
 - **NO Reflective Paint**
 - **NO Fluorescent Paint**
 - **NO Oil Based Paint**
 - **NO Glitter**
 - **NO Clear coat**
- f. **Suggestions:**
 - Use a paint with primer in it
 - Purchase Concrete Wet-Look Sealer to seal your spot
 - Use extra-fluffy rollers ... thin, cheap ones take longer
 - Use long handles and share supplies
- g. Students are required to clean up their area (including, paint and brushes) when they are finished.
- h. **DO NOT COVER THE WHITE LINES, FRONT CURB/BUMPER BLOCK, OR NUMBER OF THE PARKING SPACE.** Students must leave 4 inches between the white lines and the design. It is advisable to tape this border off when painting.
- i. Designs must be school appropriate. The following items are prohibited:
 - **No offensive language, pictures, flags or symbols.**
 - **No negative, offensive, or rude language.**
 - **No “gang-style” tagging or affiliations.**
 - **No nicknames, no girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. (ONLY your own name)**

Note: Prohibited items will be painted over at the discretion of the Principal, Assistant Principal, or School Resource Officer. Disciplinary action may be taken and you will forfeit your right to an assigned parking space. Students will not be allowed to alter their spots after the assigned painting day.

Suggested Materials, Tips, and Hints

- Water based primer paint/base coat for concrete if desired
- Chalk to sketch design prior to painting.
- Paint brushes and/or paint rollers
- Paint roller extension
- Paint pans or plastic containers for water
- Paint and brushes
- Blue painters tape (4 inches wide)
- Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
- Broom and/or dust blower to sweep spot
- Old cloths or paper towels
- A bag for your trash
- Sunshade, Sunscreen, umbrellas, sunglasses, hats
- Water, snacks
- Lawn chairs, stool, towel to sit on
- People to help
