

Spanish Teacher Vacancy

Description of the position

He/she is facilitator of learning for children and is responsible for teaching skills and concepts that will enable students to successfully function physically, intellectually emotionally, and psychologically in contemporary society. The teacher should strive to develop each student to his/her potential.

Qualifications

- Hold at least a class “A” certificate endorsed in area of instruction issued by the Mississippi Department of Education.
- Must have a 140 endorsement in Spanish.
- Have met other qualifications and requirements as established by the school district.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop lessons that are aligned to standards and represent a coherent sequence of learning and reflect collaboration with other school staff within and across disciplines to enrich learning
- Provides lessons that have high levels of learning for all students including appropriate scaffolding that effectively builds student understanding, tracks student progress toward mastery, differentiated instruction, and relevant connections to students’ prior experiences or learning opportunities.
- Assists students in taking responsibility for learning and monitors student learning by communicating lesson goals, using formative assessments to monitor students self-progress, giving actionable and timely feedback, provides opportunities for students to self-assess and correct their own errors, and provides opportunities for students to demonstrate what they have learned and how it advances goals/interests.
- Provides multiple ways for students to make meaning of content through various techniques including a variety of explanations and multiple representations of concepts, extended productive discussion, effective questioning to support students’ attainment of learning goals, making connections to other content across disciplines, and connecting content to real-world application.
- Manages a learning-focused classroom community by creating routines and expectations for student. Monitoring student behavior to maximize instructional time, providing effective collaborative learning opportunities, and providing students an opportunity to take academic leadership roles that promote learning.
- Manages classroom space, time, resources (including technology when appropriate) effectively for student learning
- Creates and maintains a classroom of respect for all students
- Engages in professional learning
- Establishing and maintains effective communication with families/guardians
- Follows the Mississippi Code of Ethics
- Demonstrates accuracy in record keeping and promptness in meeting deadlines
- Relates without difficulty to staff members
- Follows establishing school board policies and procedures
- Displays professional behavior (integrity, confidentiality, etc.) exhibiting a commitment to the school and the district both in and out of school
- Is punctual and conscientious in school attendance and participates in school related functions
- Perform all other duties and responsibilities assigned by the Principal or Superintendent



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
